#### Cons

- Easier to students to lose focus
- Uneven distribution of interaction amongst class
- Difficult for teachers to move easily from student to student

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#### Pros

- Easier to interact with entire class
- Encourages discussion and participation
- Fosters connection between students and educator
- Large area for presentations and demonstrations

#### Cons

- Not suitable for work in small groups
- May overwhelm shy students
- May be difficult to control behavior
- Larger classes may have difficulty engaging in discussions


#### Pros

- Encourages interaction of all students
- Creates a more personal and safe environment for students to convey their ideas
- Promotes cooperation and teamwork
- Develops reflection, problem solving, and communication skills
- Flexibility to strategically form groups
- Suitable for small spaces


#### Cons

- Increased noise level, distractions, and off-task behavior
- Decreased productivity
- Less individual accountability (ex. strongest student may do the bulk of the work)
- Harder to assess students' abilities and level of understanding

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




